What does a woman need most when she is facing an unexpected pregnancy? Encouragement and support! She needs first to hear that she can choose life: "You've got this! You can do this!" Second, she needs to know that someone will support her in this act of bravery and courage; she needs to know that she is not alone.

Often an untold story, the backbone and heartbeat of the pro-life movement is this very support, present in the more than 3,000 pregnancy resource centers (PRCs) and 400 maternity homes nationwide offering help to women facing unexpected pregnancies. These centers care for mothers and children through a wide range of services including housing, counseling, prenatal care, baby supplies (e.g., diapers, clothing, formula), parenting classes, and adoption support. While the false narrative persists, that prolife Americans ignore babies after birth, the real story is that PRCs and maternity homes, among many other organizations, substantively care for women, their children and their families before and after their babies are born, walking with them every step of the way.

Despite their continuous work to build a culture of life since the Dobbs decision, PRCs have become the targets of political, informational, and even physical attacks. The abortion industry, their politicians, and pro-abortion media pundits claim that PRCs engage in deceptive practices, calling them "fake clinics" that provide "misleading information" to the women they serve. Such accusations are baseless, with the truth being that many PRCs are licensed clinics staffed with board-certified medical personnel, and that PRCs steadfastly uphold their mission of empowering women and offering compassionate support for life-affirming alternatives to abortion.

Those of us in the pro-life movement will continue supporting these life-giving organizations and the incredible work they do to ensure that no woman ever must walk alone. The 2024 March for Life is an opportunity to celebrate the life-affirming work and support of these centers, whose doors are open to every mother and father who need help or resources to carry a baby to term. It is through this offer of love, support, and companionship every step of the way, that we walk With Every Woman, For Every Child and build a culture that affirms the beauty and dignity of every human life.

- The March for Life Rally will take place at noon at 12th St. on the National Mall, in between Madison and Jefferson Dr. Following the Rally, the March will begin on Madison Drive between 10th and 12th at approximately 1:00p.m.
- Throughout your stay in D.C., please be respectful of residents and commuters. Let's show the nation's capital how passionate, polite, and respectful pro-lifers really are!
- Do not leave trash or signs on the grounds of the National Mall, Supreme Court, or Capitol. If trash bins are full, please carry your trash or signs with you until you find an available trash bin.
- Do not engage with counter-protestors. If they try to engage you, ignore them as best you can. However, if you are comfortable doing so, use your phone to video the situation. This is for your safety.
- Once again, please be respectful of all people and stay focused on the cause of promoting and celebrating life, lovingly and graciously.

SPEAKERS



Danny Gokey

Three-time Grammy Nominee, three-time KLOVE Male Vocalist of the Year, Dove Award winner, and eight-time Dove Award Nominee, Danny Gokey became a favorite of millions of fans as a Top 3 finalist on Season Eight of *American Idol*. Following *Idol*,

Gokey dropped his first album, *My Best Days* and has since celebrated a series of No. 1s including his follow-up releases *Hope In Front of Me, Rise, Haven't Seen It Yet, Jesus People* and holiday albums, *Christmas Is Here* and *The Greatest Gift*.

Spawning singles like, "We All Need Jesus" "Rise," "The Comeback," "Love God Love People," and RIAA Gold-certified "Hope In Front of Me", "Tell Your Heart to Beat Again" and "Haven't Seen It Yet," Danny Gokey has cemented his place on the radio charts with multi-week, multi-chart-topping runs in the United States, Canada, and now Latin markets with the releases of Spanish singles and collaborations. The desire to make a broader impact with his message of hope led to the founding of nonprofit organization Better Than I Found It, which is doing community giveback 'Bus Stops' during his touring initiatives. He and his wife Leyicet also launched *Livin' la Vida Gokey*, a podcast featuring conversations about faith and family. Bishop John and the Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops of the United States of America

Bishop John (Abdalah) is a distinguished clergyman holding a Doctor of Ministry degree in Pastoral Care from Pittsburgh Theological Seminary and a Master of Divinity from St. Vladimir's Sem-

inary. With over 33 years of dedicated service to the priesthood, he served as the Dean of St. George Cathedral in Pittsburgh for 16 years. His contributions extend to pastoral counseling, education, and leadership roles, including teaching at the St. John of Damascus Institute in Lebanon.

Beyond his pastoral duties, Bishop John has served as the editor of *The Word* magazine, the Spiritual Advisor for the Antiochian Women, and Dean of Western Pennsylvania clergy and churches. His consecration as Auxiliary of the Diocese of Worcester and New England in 2011 marked a significant moment in his illustrious career. Married to Joanne Josephs until her passing in 2008, Bishop John is a devoted father and a respected figure in the Antiochian Orthodox Christian Archdiocese of North America.



Antonio de Mello, Community of Jesus, Brazil

The Jesus Child Community is at the forefront of the defense of life in Brazil. Founded in 1990 by Antonio "Tônio" de Mello, it is a private association of the faithful based in the city of Petrópolis, in the State of Rio de Janeiro. There, in a rural setting, Tonio, along

with a group of consecrated volunteers, provides a loving environment and comprehensive care for 46 individuals with serious disabilities, some caused by failed abortions. Tonio has legally adopted all of them, whom he refers to and treats as his sons. In recent years, the Community has been strengthening ties with Catholic and pro-life institutions in the United States.



Jean Marie Davis

Jean Marie Davis is the Executive Director of Branches Pregnancy Resource Center in Brattleboro, Vermont. She has overcome sex trafficking and is an advocate for those facing trafficking, homelessness, and unplanned pregnancy. She is the mother of an

eight-year-old son whose life was saved with the help of a pregnancy center. Davis is now a published author and a graduate of Northpoint Bible College.



Benjamin Watson

Benjamin Watson is a former NFL tight end, as well as a writer, a speaker, and an activist. He is a college football studio analyst with the SEC Network, and he serves as VP of strategic relationships with the Human Coalition, one of the largest pro-life and

pro-woman organizations in the country. His latest book, *The New Fight For Life*, casts a vision for life and justice in post-*Roe* America. Along with his wife, Kirsten, he is the founder of The Watson 7 Foundation, a nonprofit focused on strengthening families. They live in Georgia with their seven children.



Jim Daly

Jim Daly is a husband, father, author, and broadcaster. He is the president of Focus on the Family and host of its daily radio broadcast which is heard by more than 6 million listeners a week on nearly 2,000 radio stations across the U.S. The show has been

honored as Program of the Year by the National Religious Broadcasters.

Daly is also the host of a new podcast, ReFOCUS with Jim Daly, in which he interviews respected thinkers and influencers of our day. In each episode, listeners will be challenged, inspired, and equipped to engage the culture by sharing God's truth with others in a loving and graceful way. Under his leadership, the ministry has reinvigorated its traditional focus on helping couples build strong marriages and raise healthy, resilient kids. Daly and his wife, Jean, have two sons and live in Colorado Springs, Colorado.



Aisha Taylor

Aisha Taylor is the author of Navigating the Impossible: A Survival Guide for Single Moms From Pregnancy Through the First Year of Motherhood. Aisha has a powerful testimony of choosing life and navigating motherhood that we are excited for you all to

hear. Now, Aisha works hard to equip single women as they prepare for and navigate motherhood emotionally, financially, and beyond after experiencing an unexpected pregnancy.



Pastor Greg Laurie and Cathe Laurie

Greg Laurie is the senior pastor of Harvest Christian Fellowship, with campuses in California and Hawaii. He began his pastoral ministry in 1973 at the age of 19, leading a Bible study of 30 people. Since then, God has transformed that small group into one of

the largest churches in America. Harvest Christian Fellowship just celebrated its 50th year of ministry.

Laurie is the featured speaker of the Harvest Crusades and hosts nationally syndicated radio and television programs. He has authored over 70 books and released several films, including the book *Jesus Revolution*, a recounting of the Jesus Movement of the 1960s and '70s, which was recently made into a motion picture in partnership with Kingdom Story Company and Lionsgate. He is also the general editor of the ECPA-award-winning *New Believer's Bible*.

Greg has been married to Cathe Laurie for 50 years. They have two sons, Christopher and Jonathan, and five grandchildren.



Dominick Tolentino

Dominick Tolentino is a senior at Penn State University studying Architectural Engineering. He was born and raised Catholic and has been an avid pro-life advocate since going to college and joining the Students for Life club. This is his second year as pres-

ident of the club, and they have formed close relations with the State College Pregnancy Resource Center, fundraising and donating any needed supplies for the women and children who come seeking help. He, along with the rest of the members, has worked tirelessly to form a space at Penn State where other students can be unapologetically pro-life.



Speaker Mike Johnson

Speaker Mike Johnson is the 56th Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives and a Republican member of Congress proudly serving Louisiana's Fourth District. On October 25, 2023, he was elected unanimously by his House Republican colleagues to serve

as the Speaker. After a tenure of less than 6.8 years in the House, Mike was given the honor faster than any person in history except for Speaker John G. Carlisle in 1883, who had previously served for only 6.75 years. As a Member of Congress, he represents the nearly 760,000 residents of 16 parishes in the northwest and western regions of his state. Mike was first elected to Congress on December 10, 2016, by the largest margin of victory in his region in more than 50 years and is currently serving in his fourth term in Congress.

Prior to being Speaker, Mike was elected by his colleagues to serve as Vice Chairman of the House Republican Conference, one of the seven elected leadership positions for Republicans in the House of Representatives, as well as Deputy Whip. He was also previously honored to serve as chairman of the Republican Study Committee, the largest caucus of conservatives in Congress, known as "the intellectual arsenal of conservatism in the House."



Congressman Chris Smith

Elected in 1980, U.S. Rep. Chris Smith (R-Manchester, N.J.) is currently in his 22nd two-year term in the U.S. House of Representatives, and serves residents of the Fourth Congressional District of New Jersey. Mr. Smith serves as a senior member on the For-

eign Affairs Committee and Chairman of its Global Health, Global Human Rights and International Organizations Subcommittee. He also serves as the Co-Chair of the Tom Lantos Human Rights Commission, Chairman of the bipartisan House/ Senate/White House Congressional-Executive Commission on China (CECC) and as "Special Representative" on Human Trafficking for the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly. Previously, he served as Co-Chair and highest-ranking House member of the bipartisan House/Senate Commission on Security and Cooperation in Europe (CSCE) serving as chairman five times, and served as Chairman of the Veterans Committee (two terms), the Foreign Affairs' Subcommittee on Human Rights and International Operations, and the Subcommittee on Africa.
