Is registration required?

The New Jersey March for Life is a public event that is open to all pro-life New Jerseyans. Registration is not required for the Rally or March, but is highly encouraged to stay updated on the details!

Will signs be provided?

We encourage you to be creative and make your own signs! March for Life will be providing signs to the public, as will many other organizations in attendance at the event. There are a few rules that attendees must follow according to the Statehouse: Signs can be outside of the statehouse at the rally/march but cannot go inside the statehouse! Signs can be held by your hands but cannot be held up by wood/metal/similar firm material.

Signs you bring can't be tied up to, hung on, or taped to statehouse property (i.e. walls or handrails).

I want to lobby my legislator, but I'm not sure what to do. Where do I start?

We encourage you to continue your day as a voice for life by contacting your legislators prior to the March and set up a time to meet with them before or after the March and Rally. If you do not have an appointment, you can still stop by your member's office and leave a message for them with their staff. You can find your legislators here.
