

## MARCH GUIDELINES


While walking and riding the metro in Washington, D.C., please be respectful of residents and commuters. You are a representative of the pro-life community.

Avoid engaging with counter-protesters. If they try to engage you, ignore them as best you can. However, if you are comfortable doing so, use your phone to video the situation. This is for your protection.

How you carry yourself can change hearts and minds.

Do not leave trash or signs on the grounds of the National Mall, Supreme Court, or Capitol. This is our nation's capital, and we should treat it with dignity and respect.

Once again, please be respectful of all people and stay focused on the cause of promoting and celebrating life, lovingly and graciously.

You are the heart of the pro-life movement; the best "ambassadors" for life! We are so very grateful for your witness and want to do everything possible to support and protect you as you stand for life at the 2025 March for Life.



#### DR. CHERYL WHITE

Dr. White is a professor of history at Louisiana State University at Shreveport, where she holds the endowed Hubert Humphreys Professorship. She currently serves on the board of directors of the Shroud of Turin Education and Research Association [STERA] and has published original research from the Vatican Secret Archives on the history of the Shroud for international journals and conferences. She works closely with the Center for the International Study of the Turin, and with Father Peter Mangum, curates the esteemed Richard Orareo Collection.



#### VERY REVEREND PETER MANGUM

Father Mangum is the paster of Jesus the Good Shepherd Church in Monroe, Louisiana, and is co-host of the 36 episode podcast, Who Is the Man of the Shroud? His research in the Vatican Secret Archives has been published for international journals and conferences, and he is honored to work closely with the Center for the International Study of the Shroud in Turin. With Dr. Cheryl White, he curates the Richard Orareo Collection of rare artworks and artifacts related to the devotional history of the Shroud.
