



Dropoff: CT State Supreme Court, 231 Capitol Ave, Hartford, CT 06105 - Capitol Ave side, at crosswalk. Shuttles will not enter the Capitol grounds in order to avoid intermingling with charter bus traffic.

Bringing a bus?

Let us know you're coming! If you are bringing a bus please <u>fill out this</u> <u>form.</u> Registered buses will receive updates and important information on parking leading up to the event.

Parking for Buses

Reserved bus parking will be along the march route. After dropping of marchers, buses can proceed to Elm St. for street parking along the side of the road. Parking will be on the Westbound side of the street so buses should enter Elm St. from Main St. and proceed down the street, filling parking closest to Trinity St. first.



Bus Drop-Off & Pick Up

Buses can drop off groups in the driveway surrounding the statehouse. Enter from Trinity St.

Buses can pick up at their parking location on Elm St. or on Trinity St. near where the march began (see map).

Please note buses need to complete drop-offs before the rally begins at 12:00p.m.

Is registration required?

The Connecticut March for Life is a public event that is open to all pro-life Connecticuters. <u>Registration</u> is not required for the Rally or March, but is highly encouraged to stay updated on the details!

Where can individuals park?

Individual parking for cars is available on local streets and at various parking lots in the area. A map of garage and street parking can be found <u>HERE</u>.

Will signs be provided?

We encourage you to be creative and bring your own signs! It is likely that many groups will have signs available as well. You can find additional sign ideas <u>HERE</u>.

I want to lobby my legislator, but I'm not sure what to do. Where do I start?

We encourage you to contact your legislators prior to the March and setup a time to meet with them after the March and Rally. If you do not have an appointment, you can still go to the Legislative Office Building, which is connected directly to the Capitol, and leave a message for them with the receptionist.
