### Drop-Off

Early arrival buses will drop-off in the green zones, then go park at Mt. Hope Church-Creyts Campus (202 S Creyts Rd).


Volunteers will communicate to later buses to conduct drop-off and to park in green zones around capitol.

### Pick-Up

Buses parked in the green zones will be first to pick-up.

Remaining buses will then come from Mt. Hope back to green zones around capitol for their pick-up.

# frequently asked questions

## ● **Is registration required?**

The Michigan March for Life is a public event that is open to all pro-life Michiganders. Registration is not required for the Rally or March, but is highly encouraged to stay updated on the details! [RSVP here!](#)

## ● **Where can individuals park?**

There are several [public parking lots](#) available in downtown Lansing. Also, there is parking available for marchers at Lansing Catholic High School two miles away from the Capitol, as well as Trinity Lutheran Church.

## ● **Will signs be provided?**

We encourage you to be creative and make your own signs! March for Life will be providing signs to the public, as will many other organizations in attendance at the event.

PLEASE NOTE: Signs you bring cannot be tied up to, hung on, or taped to Capitol property (i.e. walls or handrails); nor can they be taken into the Capitol Building or other state buildings.

## ● **I want to lobby my legislator, but I'm not sure what to do. Where do I start?**

We encourage you to continue your day as a voice for life by contacting your legislators prior to the March and set up a time to meet with them before or after the March and Rally.
