

Bringing a bus?

Let us know you're coming! If you are bringing a bus, [follow the link HERE](#) to register your bus and apply for cost subsidizing through the Knights of Columbus!

If you are bringing a bus that you would NOT like us to highlight but would still like to receive updates and important information leading up to the event, please still register and indicate that there is not space on the bus.

All registered buses will receive an email in the week before the Connecticut March for Life with important information regarding bus logistics.

Streets for Bus Parking

There will be reserved bus parking on Capitol Street. Registered buses will receive an email with details on reserved parking.

Buses must be registered to ensure reserved parking. If you did not register your bus, extra reserved parking is on a first-come-first-served basis and additional buses may need to find their own parking.




Bus Drop-Off & Pick Up

Frequently Asked *questions*

Is registration required?

The Connecticut March for Life is a public event that is open to all pro-life Connecticut residents. Registration is not required for the Rally or March, but is highly encouraged to stay updated on the details!

Where can individuals park?

There are several public parking lots in downtown Hartford. Depending on which public parking lot you choose, you will be able to walk to the Capitol North Steps!

Will signs be provided?

We encourage you to be creative and bring your own signs! It is likely that many groups will have signs available as well. You can find additional sign ideas HERE.

I want to lobby my legislator, but I'm not sure what to do. Where do I start?

We encourage you to continue your day as a voice for life by contacting your legislators prior to the March to set up a time to meet with them before or after the March and Rally.
